



SRF Scoring Map: Loan Priority Score (max. score 405)

As part of the SRF loan application process, the Illinois EPA uses a “loan priority scoring” methodology to determine where a lead service line replacement loan application placed on the “Project Priority List” is ranked for funding consideration. The score is based on the U.S. Census Bureau’s American Community Survey (ACS) 5-Year Data, using census tract(s) included in the project area and based on the percentiles of seven census tract variables. The maximum score is 405 based on seven of eight* scoring variables.

*An additional variable, Lead Service Line Percentage, is not included in the scores shown here. The data is not publicly available at the census tract level. It will be added to the final loan priority score by the agency for a maximum of 45 points for a maximum final total score of 450.
